



DOCTOR OF MINISTRY

The practice of Christian ministry is an increasingly complex and demanding task. Emmanuel's DMin allows you to integrate your practical ministry experience with additional advanced-level coursework, all accommodating your schedule.

THE PROGRAM

Emmanuel's goal is to equip the church with leaders ready to serve the Lord in ways which are biblically grounded, historically informed, doctrinally clear, and relevant to the contemporary context.

Emmanuel's DMin degree will help you better analyze community dynamics and personal needs, revitalize your ministerial gifts, develop new strategies and tools for ministry, prepare and motivate others in ministry, and continue to grow in the practice of ministry at its most mature and effective level. You'll also enjoy the support of fellow ministers and peers.

CURRICULUM

This three- to five-year 36-credit hour program enables ministers to integrate practical experience in ministry with doctoral-level coursework. Students often take two to four courses per year that fit with their personal schedules and church calendars.

Classical Core 15 hrs
(Christian Theology, Church History, New Testament, Old Testament)

Ministry Core 15 hrs
(Choose from Church Administration, Church Growth, Counseling, Development, Evangelism, Leadership, Preaching, Teaching, World Mission, Worship)

Project & Methodology 6 hrs
(Design, accomplish, and evaluate a ministerial program)

SCHEDULE

Classes are offered through one-week on-campus intensives, which provide invaluable face-to-face instruction and interaction with your classmates and professors. These weeks begin Monday at 1 pm and generally end Friday afternoon, and they are held at Emmanuel's campus in beautiful Northeast Tennessee.

FACULTY

You'll learn from Emmanuel's expert faculty and also benefit from highly qualified guest professors who bring broad expertise and experience. Each student works with a faculty advisor who guides the student in planning his or her academic program each term and serves as a special counselor and mentor throughout the seminary experience.
